- B. An applicant who completed the entire 16-year education from elementary school to university in foreign countries(not Korea)

\* Applicants must meet one of the two conditions above.

## 4. Selection Process

Documents (100%) + Interview (100%) = Total 200%

Interdisciplinary Arts Department: Documents (100%) + Interview (100%) + performance(200%) = Total 400%

\* Overseas applicants can have interview by phone. Departments may or may not conduct interview. Each department will announce its schedule and method for such interview
