0. Before we begin --- Attendance during the first week of classes?

- If you don't attend the classes that you changed during the "Course Registration Correction" period, they will be marked as absences during the first week of classes.
 - 1. The first week of classes is considered the official academic schedule, and it is not an orientation week
 - 2. Students who are not registered for the course will be marked as absent when checking attendance
 - 3. Even if you have made changes to your course registration during the "Course Registration Correction" period, if you do not attend the classes you have registered for, it will be considered as an absence and will be treated accordingly.

3. Course Registration Correction (수강신청 확인 및 정정)



During the first week after the semester starts, there is a period to make modifications to the courses you have already registered for during the regular course registration period.



The first week is the final opportunity to make changes to your course registration. Please make sure to take note of this.

3. Course Registration Correction Etc. (수강신청 확인 및 정정)

4. Course withdrawal (수강중도포기)



Course Withdrawal System allows you to cancel enrollment for the courses you wish to drop among the courses you are currently taking in the current semester.



It is not a process to remove or replace the earned credits, but rather to "withdraw from the course".



September 25th, 2023 (Mon) 10:00 AM ~ September 29th, 2023 (Fri) 3:00 PM (Must on time).



Access http://suwings.syu.ac.kr and proceed with <u>the online application</u> (Not available for offline application).



4. Course withdrawal Etc. (수강중도포기)



① Eligibility: Currently enrolled students.

② Only cancellation of courses for the current semester is allowed. New registrations or course changes are <u>not possible</u>.

③ September 25th (Mon) to September 29th (Fri) until 3:00 PM (Must on time).

 ④ Log in to SU-WINGs (https://suwings.syu.ac.kr) and submit the application online. (Not available for offline application).

(5) Procedure:

- 1) Log in to SU-WINGs (https://suwings.syu.ac.kr).
- 2) Go to Course Information (수강정보) -> Course Withdrawal Application. (수강중도포기 신청)
- 3) Course Withdrawal Application (중도포기신청) Check the checkbox next to the course(s) you want to withdraw from and click on the withdrawal application. (No need to print or submit the application form).



4) Course Withdrawal Cancellation (중도포기취소) - If you wish to re-enroll in a previously withdrawn course, click on Course Withdrawal Cancellation.
