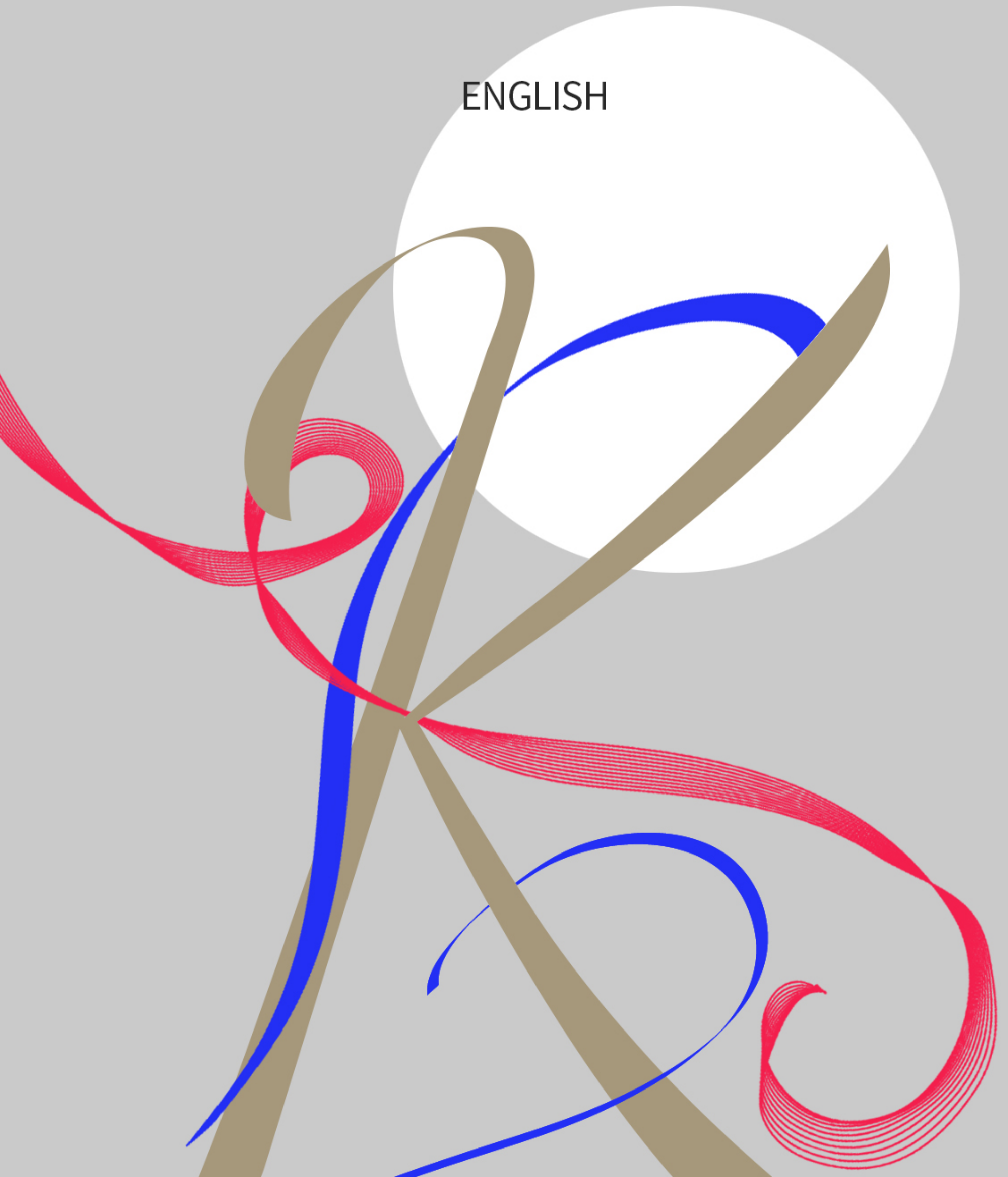

VISA

- A short-term visa (D-2-8) may be required if your country requires a visa to enter Korea. For more information about visa requirements or applications, please contact your Korean Embassy or Consulate to see if you need a visa to enter Korea. Please contact us by e-mail to obtain the necessary documents for visa application.

INSURANCE

- All students must be insured before entering Korea. If you are a foreign national, you can insure your travel insurance and other incidents in Korea and submit a copy. If there is no applicable insurance in Korea, we will apply insurance by connecting the insurance company by applying. If you do not apply for insurance or do not submit a copy of your insurance receipt, you may not be admitted.
