Korean Track	Those who have Level 3 or higher in the Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) (However, applicants with Level 2 or higher may apply for the Integrated Arts, Music and Sports Science)

TOEFL 530 (PBT 530, CBT 197, iBT 71), IELTS 5.5, CEFR B2, TEPS 601 (NEW TEPS 327) * Equivalent to the FCE (First Certificate in English, upper-intermediate level) of Cambridge English under CEFR standards (English) 2. Applicants who hold citizenship from countries where English is an official language (such as the UK, USA, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Ireland, and South Africa) are exempt from submitting language proficiency scores. 3. ## 5. Selection criteria

### 1) General criteria

- (1) Those who are absent during the interview will be disqualified.
- (2) Those who do not meet the qualifications or who provide false information, falsification, or other dishonest acts will be disqualified regardless of their grades, and their admission will be canceled even after admission (however, tuition fees already paid will be refunded in accordance with the Ministry of Education Ordinance).

### 2) Selection criteria for successful applicants

- (1) A certain number of applicants will be selected based on the total score ranking among those who passed the document screening and oral examination.
- (2) Those with the same score will be prioritized according to the following rankings:
  - ① Those with higher oral examination scores
  - ② Those with higher document screening scores
- (3) Those who do not have an average oral examination score (scores per committee member) of 60 points or more than 2/3 of the oral examination committee members give a score of less than 40 points will be disqualified.
- (4) Those who lack academic performance will not be selected regardless of the number of applicants.



## 6. Submission documents

### 6.1 Common submission documents

- 1) In principle, submission documents must be submitted in original form.
- 2) If the submission documents are not written in Korean or English, a notarized document (within 3 months) translated into Korean or English must be submitted.
- 3) Only documents issued within the past three months will be accepted.

## 7. Precautions for Applicants

- 1) All examinees must confirm the oral examination location and enter the waiting room at the designated time. You must bring your ID card during the oral examination.
- 2) Documents already submitted cannot be cancelled or corrected, and the application fee and submitted documents will not be returned.
- 3) The admission evaluation content and scores will not be disclosed.
- 4) Applicants are responsible for any disadvantages resulting from missing, incorrect, or illegible submitted documents.
- 5) If there are two or fewer applicants per department and degree program, the application may be canceled, and the application fee may be refunded in the case of a canceled application.
- 6) The announcement of successful applicants will be posted on the university's graduate school website (not individually notified), and the acceptance letter and tuition notice will be printed from the university's graduate school website (<http://www.syu.ac.kr/grad/>).
- 7) Successful applicants must pay the registration fee to the designated bank within the registration period. Failure to pay the registration fee within the period will result in disqualification.
- 8) Successful applicants must subscribe to the National Health Insurance Service from March 2021 in accordance with the National Health Insurance Act and its Enforcement Regulations.
- 9) Matters not specified in these guidelines shall be determined by the Graduate School Committee.

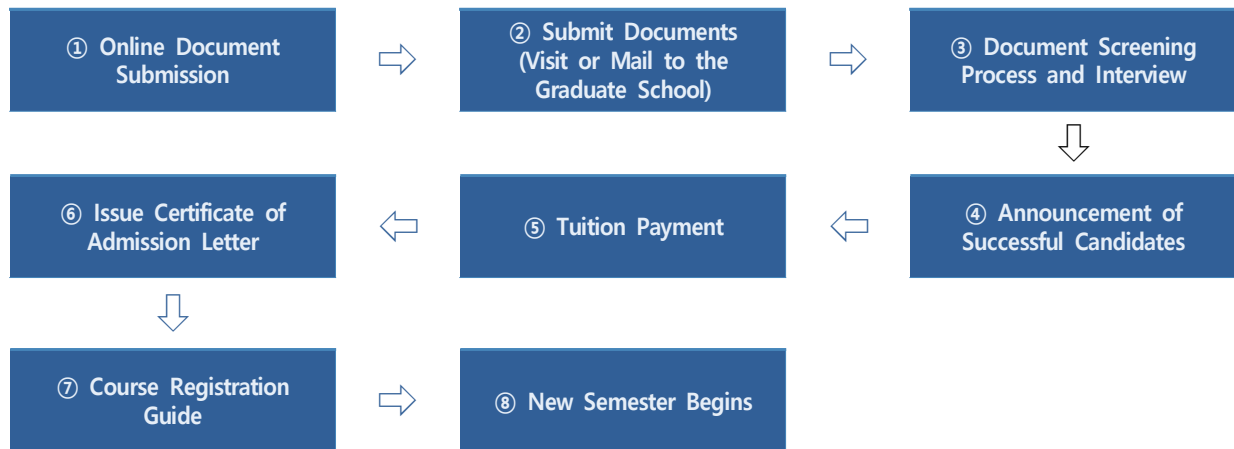

### ■ Important Information for Applicants with Approved Visas

1. Applicants who have received visa approval must book their flight and send a copy of the **flight ticket** to [global-GA@syu.ac.kr](mailto:global-GA@syu.ac.kr).
2. If you wish to move into the dormitory, you must arrive during office hours in order to receive proper guidance. If you plan to arrive outside of office hours or on weekends/public holidays, please inform us in advance.
3. Upon arrival in Korea, you are required to visit the Graduate School Administration Office(Room 101, Centennial Memorial Hall) during business hours to submit your application for the **Alien Registration Card**. Please bring KRW 50,000 in cash, your housing contract, one passport-sized photo, and your passport.
4. If you need assistance with course registration, please visit the office during business hours.

## ■ Dormitory Guide

### 1. Eligibility for Residence

- 1) Must accept the university's educational philosophy and comply with all dormitory regulations.
- 2) Applicable to 2026 academic year freshmen, continuing students, returning students, and transfer students.

### 2. Selection Method

- Applicants are selected through document review, distance priority (long-distance applicants prioritized), social consideration, and interviews.

### 3. Facility Overview

#### 1) Capacity: 1,395

- Zion Hall (Male): 460, Eden Hall (Female) 438, Salem Hall (Male) 227, B'niel Hall (Female) 227, Newstart Hall (Female) 43

#### 2) Buildings & Facilities

- 4 dormitory buildings with 1-person, 2-person, 3-person, and 4-person rooms, plus a dining hall, facilities for students with disabilities, lounges, fitness rooms, study rooms, laundry rooms, chapel, counseling rooms, and meeting rooms. Each room is equipped with a dedicated internet line.
- Zion Hall and Eden Hall: shared bathrooms and showers in corridors.
- Salem Hall and B'niel Hall: each room has a private bathroom and shower.

#### ■ How to Get to Sahmyook University from Incheon International Airport

1. **Airport Bus No. 6100 (interval: 15–30 minutes)** → Get off at Taereung Entrance Station → From Exit 7, take a bus toward Sahmyook University (82A, 82B, 1155, 115, 155) → Get off at Sahmyook University Stop → Visit the Graduate School Office (Room 101, 1st Floor, Centennial Memorial Hall)
2. **Airport Bus No. 8844 (Reservation required; check schedule in advance)** → Take Airport Bus No. 8844 → Get off at Byeollae Station (Exit 4: Bus 86 / Exits 2, 3, or 5: Bus 1155) → Get off at Sahmyook University Rear Gate, Nongol, or Forena Apartment Stop → Visit the Graduate School Office (Room 101, 1st Floor, Centennial Memorial Hall)
3. **Airport Bus No. 8843 (Reservation required; check schedule in advance)** → Get off at Guri Intercity/Airport Bus Stop → Cross the street and take Bus No. 2-2 from in front of Guri Station Exit 1 (Runs approximately every 35 minutes on weekdays) → Get off at Sahmyook University (The bus enters the campus and turns around near the main auditorium. Do NOT get off at the main gate.) → Visit the Graduate School Office (Room 101, 1st Floor, Centennial Memorial Hall)
4. **Airport Bus No. 4800 (Reservation required; check schedule in advance)** → Get off at Galmae Station Stop → Cross the street and take Bus No. 2-2 (Runs approximately every 35 minutes on weekdays) → Get off at Sahmyook University (The bus enters the campus and turns around near the main auditorium. Do NOT get off at the main gate.) → Visit the Graduate School Office (Room 101, 1st Floor, Centennial Memorial Hall)
5. **Airport Railroad (AREX) + Subway** → Get off at Gongdeok Station → Transfer to Subway Line 6 (toward Bonghwasan / Sinnae) → Get off at Hwarangdae Station → From Exit 1, take a bus toward Sahmyook University (82A, 82B, 1155, 115, 155, 202) → Get off at Sahmyook University Stop → Visit the Graduate School Office (Room 101, 1st Floor, Centennial Memorial Hall)
